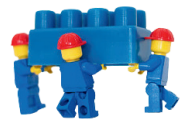

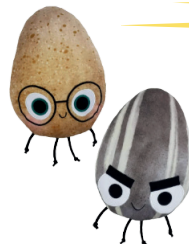


ICE CREAM SCAVENGER HUNT
